Sunday, April 14th

- [15] Watch this video: <https://bibleproject.com/explore/video/ephesians/> and write down what stands out to you in light of all the time we've spent in Ephesians.
- [16] Ephesians 1:1-14 | We're going to re-read Ephesians over the next two weeks. Of all the blessings we have "in Christ," what stands out to you as you read today?
- [17] Ephesians 1:15-23 | How has your heart been enlightened by what you've read and heard taught about in Ephesians over the last year?
- [18] Ephesians 2:1-10 | Do you really believe that we've been saved by grace and not works? How does your spiritual life reflect that reality?
- [19] Ephesians 2:11-22 | How have you seen the Gospel bring unity in places that were previously not united?
- [20] Spend some time praying the second half of Ephesians 1 over your family and friends.

Sunday, April 21st




- [22] Ephesians 3:1-13 | What stands out to you in this passage?
- [23] Ephesians 3:14-21 | How has the Gospel rooted you in love?
- [24] Ephesians 4:1-16 | What is the hardest part of the calling Paul is talking about for you personally? Where do you most need the Spirit to empower you to live this out?
- [25] Ephesians 4:17-32 | Spend some time in reflection – who might you need to extend forgiveness to? Is there anything you need to put off from your old life in order to walk more fully in Christ?
- [26] Ephesians 5:1-21 | How has our time in Ephesians helped you to more fully "discern what is pleasing to the Lord" (v.10)?
- [27] Spend some time praying the second half of Ephesians 3 over your family and friends.

Sunday, April 28th

- [29] Ephesians 5:22-33 | What is something you learned about God's design for the role of husbands and wives that you didn't know before we started studying Ephesians?
- [30] Ephesians 6:1-9 | What is the most challenging part of this passage for you?

Welcome to our April 2024 reading plan! We will be finishing our journey through Ephesians and spending some time reflecting on all that we've learned in our time in this beautiful book of the bible. Before your read each day, meditate on Ephesians 6:24 , pray for one person to know Christ  and pray for one person to grow in Him .

- [April 1] Ephesians 6:18-20 | Do you actively engage in prayer as a weapon against spiritual attacks? When was the last time you prayed for someone in your life who is struggling?
- [2] James 5:13-18 | Does your prayer life look like the examples in this passage? Is there anything new in here you haven't prayed for?
- [3] Matthew 6:6-13 | Why do you think this is the prayer Jesus taught us? How can we use this prayer as a weapon in the spiritual battle around us?
- [4] Mark 9:14-29 | How does this story challenge your understanding or belief about spiritual warfare?
- [5] 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 | We've read this verse before. How can prayer be a powerful weapon in destroying strongholds if sin is in our lives and the lives of those around us?
- [6] Spend some time in prayer and ask the Holy Spirit to make you more aware of the spiritual battle around you and ask Him to call you into prayer more often when challenges arise.

Sunday, April 7th

- [8] Ephesians 6:21-24 | What stands out to you in this passage?
- [9] Ephesians 6:21-22 | What role does testimony play in building our faith? How do you see that in these verses?
- [10] Revelation 12:10-11 | According to this passage, what power does our testimony have?
- [11] Ephesians 6:23-24 | What final things does Paul emphasize in his closing greeting? Why do you think he chooses those?
- [12] Colossians 4:7-9 | Tychicus shows up again here as the missionary delivering Paul's message to the Colossians. What do you think it would have been like to travel around on behalf of Paul and minister to the early churches?
- [13] Spend some time in prayer, praying Paul's blessing from Ephesians 6 over your family and anyone you would consider a beloved brother or sister in Christ.
