DAILY READINGS

Welcome to our March 2024 reading plan! We will be winding down in Ephesians with a focus on Spiritual warfare, as well as celebrating Holy Week and Easter. Before you read each day meditate on Ephesians 6:10-11 , pray for one person to know Christ  and pray for one person to grow in Him .

Memorization & Meditation:

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil!” – Ephesians 6:10-11

WEEK 1

- [March 1] 1 John 4:4 | Sometimes focusing on the reality of spiritual warfare can feel discouraging. How does this verse lift your spirits?
- [2] Spend some time in prayer and ask the Lord to convict you in any area that you need to be better equipped for the spiritual battle ahead.

WEEK 2

Sunday, March 3rd

- [4] Ephesians 6:10-11 | How does spiritual warfare show up for you in your daily life?
- [5] Ephesians 6:12-13 | How does the enemy use “flesh and blood” to distract us from the real spiritual battle raging around us?
- [6] 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 | Our mind can be a significant battlefield. What does it look like for you to take every thought captive?
- [7] Ephesians 6:18 | How has prayer benefitted you in a moment or season of spiritual battle?
- [8] 1 John 4:4 | Do you believe that he who is in you is greater than he who is in the world? What hope does this verse give you today?
- [9] Spend some time in prayer and ask the Lord to increase your faith in His ability to fight for us.

WEEK 3

Sunday, March 10th

- [11] Ephesians 6:10-18 | What stands out to you as you read this now very familiar passage? What is the Lord highlighting today?
- [12] 2 Chronicles 20:1-28 | Sometimes the enemy can distract us and make us think that the battle is totally up to us. How does this verse counsel us against that?
- [13] Romans 12:14-21 | How does this response to evil and adversity run counter to the wisdom of the world? Why do you think it's a better strategy?
- [14] 1 Corinthians 15:56-57 | Though spiritual battle can be discouraging at times, never forget that we have Christ fighting for us and He has already won the battle! Spend some time meditating on this today.
- [15] Romans 8:31-38 | When we truly understand God's love for us, it is the ultimate weapon in our arsenal. How do these verses shape your identity in Christ and give you strength for the battle ahead?
- [16] Spend some time in prayer, reflecting on Christ's victory over sin and death and His coming victorious return!

WEEK 4

Sunday, March 17th

- [18] Zechariah 9:9 | As we look towards Palm Sunday and Easter, this Old Testament prophecy shows us how much care went into God's plan to send Jesus to earth. Reflect on this truth today.
- [19] John 12:1-8 | Mary's gift to Jesus was a costly sacrifice given in love to her Savior. What costly sacrifice have you made for Christ as you have walked with Him?
- [20] Matthew 21:1-11 | Historically, conquering kings entered cities on war horses. Why is it significant that Jesus entered Jerusalem not on a war horse but on a donkey?
- [21] John 12:12-19 | How does this account differ from the Matthew account from yesterday?
- [22] Revelation 7:9-12 | What strength and joy does this passage give you? Can you picture the scene?
- [23] Spend some time in prayer reflecting on Jesus' final entry into Jerusalem before His crucifixion. Ask Him to help you understand His love by reflecting on His suffering.

WEEK 5

Sunday, March 24th - Palm Sunday

- [25] John 13:21-38 | How do you think Jesus felt knowing the betrayal and rejection He was about to face? How does that shape how we listen to His final words to His disciples in the chapters ahead?
- [26] John 17 | This is Jesus' prayer for His disciples, present and future. What is God highlighting to you as you read through it? Why do you think that stands out to you?
- [27] John 18 | Go back to v.33. What stands out to you in Jesus' interaction with Pilate?
- [28] John 19 | How was Jesus fulfilling prophecies from the Old Testament even in the way that his death came about?
- [29] John 20 | How do you think you would have reacted to the resurrection of Jesus if you had been one of his original disciples? How do you think they were feeling?
- [30] Spend some time in prayer and ask the Lord to prepare your heart to celebrate His death and resurrection with the body of Christ at Antioch tomorrow!
